

Report on Awareness Programme- Oral and Dental Hygiene on 12th of May, 2022

Oral hygiene is the practice of keeping one's mouth clean and free of disease and other problems by regular brushing of the teeth (**dental hygiene**) and cleaning between the teeth. It is important that oral hygiene be carried out on a regular basis to enable prevention of dental disease and bad breath. General guidelines for adults suggest brushing at least twice a day with a fluoridated toothpaste. Cleaning between the teeth is called interdental cleaning and is as important as tooth brushing. This is because a toothbrush cannot reach between the teeth and therefore only removes about 50% of plaque from the surface of the teeth. There are many tools to clean between the teeth, including floss, tape and interdental brushes; it is up to each individual to choose which tool they prefer to use.

Sometimes white or straight teeth are associated with oral hygiene. However, a hygienic mouth can have stained teeth or crooked teeth. To improve the appearance of their teeth, people may use tooth whitening treatments and orthodontics.

There was an awareness program organised by The Oxford Dental College, where they had briefed us about the ways to maintain the dental and oral hygiene. It was an informative session wherein we got a new insight about the various aspects to be considered and taken care about our oral health.

PHASE 2: PAINTING





BEAUTIFICATION OF VANI VILAS ROAD AT BASAVANAGUDI


4th DECEMBER 2022
